HOW TO GET THERE:

The center has two entrances on County Route 14. CR14 connects State Highway 68 to Rensselaer Falls. It leaves State Highway 68 approximately 6 miles outside the village of Canton in the direction of Ogdensburg. From route 68 proceed 2.9 miles down CR14. The east entrance will be on your left across from a barn. This entrance will allow you to access the Wildflower Loop and Upland trails. On the left approximately 0.5 miles further down CR14 will be the main entrance to Indian Creek Nature Center (gated). This entrance will allow you to access the Boardwalk – Observation Deck trail (an accessible trail), the Lowland trail, the Observation Tower trail, and the western end of the Upland trail. At the end of this entrance road (0.3 miles) is a parking area.

Spring wildflowers start in mid to late April and fade by early June. Selection and timing of flowers will vary from year to year depending on rainfall and temperature.
